- Identifying, understanding & assessing risks, including using the DASH tool.
- Observe effective assessment skills in order to assess risk and safety.

Session 2:

Coercive Control

- Understanding the definition
- Exploring tactics and behaviours
- Discuss the ever changing stages of coercive control
- Understand legislation, inc., agency contribution to evidence gathering

Session 3:

DA Practitioner Updates

- Discuss / explore new procedures & services available to you in NE Lincs. *(Inc., local services, MARAC, Claire's Law, DVPO's, examples of safety plans, HBV, Trafficking, Operation Encompass)*
- Practitioner feedback on local DA services & practices *(anonymously)* to assist with future plans in NE Lincs.
